



Student Uniform & Dress Code

The P & C Association has resolved that it supports a student dress code policy for Alexandra Hills State High School because it believes that a dress code policy promotes the objectives of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006, and in particular that it:

- Promotes a safe environment for learning by enabling ready identification of students and nonstudents of the school
- Promotes an effective teaching and learning environment by eliminating the distraction of competition in dress and fashion at the school
- Promotes a sense of common purpose and belonging, consistency and unity in the daily activities of students
- Fosters mutual respect among individuals at the school by minimising visible evidence of economic, class or social differences

All students require an everyday uniform for normal class activities as well as for excursions or community-development activities unless otherwise stipulated. In addition, students will require a sports uniform for sports and Health and Physical Education classes. Students should wear their uniform correctly and with pride in all locations. Even when wearing the school uniform outside the school grounds, students are always representing Alexandra Hills State High School.

NOTE: During 2022, the P&C consulted with students, staff and the community regarding changing the formal school uniform (the sports uniform remains the same). The P&C criteria was to reduce the number of uniform items, to keep costs down and to make sure the uniform was contemporary. The consultation phase is now complete, with parents, students and staff all having shared their thoughts on the uniform options. The new style of formal uniform is being introduced in 2024 and students will have two years after this transition to the new style.




Junior Secondary Uniform - Years 7, 8 and 9

The **formal uniform** must be worn on **Mondays and Thursdays,** and for non-active school excursions, photo days and awards ceremonies. Either the formal or sports uniform can be worn Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

The sports uniform must be worn by years 7 and 9 for their "Options" program: year 7 on Fridays and year 9 on Tuesdays.

Cold Weather Options

- School jumper or jacket
- School scarf
- School black trousers / track pants
- Black, opaque, plain tights (without socks) can be worn with the school skirt
- Senior Jerseys (Year 12) can be worn with either the formal or sports uniform



Sports Uniform – all year levels

The **formal uniform** must be worn on **Mondays and Thursdays,** and for non-active school excursions, photo days and awards ceremonies. Either the formal or sports uniform can be worn Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

The sports uniform must be worn by years 7 and 9 for their "Options" program: year 7 on Fridays and year 9 on Tuesdays.

Students must also bring their sports uniform on days when they have HPE practical lessons (changing before and after the lesson) or are participating in sporting tournaments / gala days.

- School sports shirt
- School sports shorts
- White crew-cut school socks with 'AHSHS' trim
- School sports cap
- Black leather joggers





Shoes

- The only acceptable shoes are fully enclosed leather sports joggers (not mesh, canvas or suede) or leather lace-up school shoes. These must be black (no coloured emblems, stripes or laces)
- Students who do not have the correct footwear will be unable to participate in many subjects – especially practical subjects
- Specialist sport shoes must only be worn on the field or court during lessons



Hair

- Neat, clean, off the face and out of the eyes
- Shoulder length hair must be tied back with plain black band (green or gold scrunchy or ribbon is optional)
- Students are not to wear extreme hairstyles including (but not limited to) undercuts, rat-tails, mullets, shaved sections, tracks, shaved eyebrows
- Hair must be one natural colour

Jewellery

- No rings, bracelets or necklaces
- One pair of small plain gold or silver studs or sleepers in the lower lobe of the ear
- Oversize or dangling earrings are not permitted
- Students are allowed to wear clear flat retainers in piercings in the ear or nose other than the permitted piercings detailed above
- Other facial piercings are not permitted, regardless of them being clear or covered with a 'band-aid'
- Students may wear a watch

Makeup / Facial Hair

- No make-up is to be worn to school including (but not limited to) lip stick/gloss, eye shadow, eye liner, mascara, artificial lashes
- Coloured nail polish or artificial nails are not permitted
- Must be clean shaven at all times

General Appearance

- Damaged uniforms need to be repaired promptly no safety pins
- T-shirts or singlets if worn under blouses or shirts are not to be visible at any time
- No underwear is to be visible at any time
- Tattoos must not be visible and are to be covered at all times

Junior Secondary Girls' Uniform - Years 7, 8 and 9

The **formal uniform** must be worn on **Mondays and Thursdays**, and for non-active school excursions, photo days and awards ceremonies. The sports uniform must be worn by years 7 and 9 for their "Options" program: year 7 on Fridays and year 9 on Tuesdays.

- School blouse
- Green school skirt or green school shorts
- Sand coloured socks
- Black leather lace-up school shoes or black leather joggers
- Culottes (optional)



Junior Secondary Boys' Uniform – Years 7, 8 and 9

Either the formal or sports uniform can be worn Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. - Junior school shirt
- Grey school shorts or trousers
- Grey school socks with green and gold bands
- Black leather belt with plain buckle (optional)
- Black leather lace-up school shoes or black leather joggers







Senior Secondary Girls' Uniform – Years 10, 11 and 12

The **formal uniform** must be worn on **Mondays and Thursdays,** and for non-active school excursions, photo days and awards ceremonies. Either the formal or sports uniform can be worn Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

- School blouse
- Green school skirt or green school shorts
- Sand coloured socks
- Year 10-11 or Year 12 blouse tie to be worn all year
- Culottes (optional)



Senior Secondary Boys' Uniform – Years 10, 11 and 12

The **formal uniform** must be worn on **Mondays and Thursdays,** and for non-active school excursions, photo days and awards ceremonies. Either the formal or sports uniform can be worn Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

- Senior school shirt (tucked in)
- Grey school shorts or trousers
- Grey school socks with green and gold bands
- Black leather belt with plain buckle
- Black leather lace-up school shoes or black leather joggers
- Year 10-11 or Year 12 shirt tie to be worn during Terms 2 and 3
