


SOUTHSIDE PREMIER LEAGUE

The Southside Premier League (SPL) competition is an invitational competition, which provides high level basketball from schools within South East QLD. Each school must enter four teams in the competition. A senior boys and girls, which contains players from year 10-12. The junior boys and girls involve players from year 7-9. The first 'Gala Day' for the SPL competition was scheduled for the last day of term 1. However, the snap lockdown prevented this from going ahead. Rest assured the 'Gala Day' will be rescheduled.

Round 1 of the SPL competition meant we had to travel to Wellington Point. Our junior teams started the afternoon very well, both winning!
