



Basketball Academy - Application



The Basketball Academy program aims to improve girl and boy basketball players in Years 7 - 12. Students who are successful in selection into the Basketball Academy will train as separate girl and boy teams, in three program divisions – Introductory (Year 7), Junior (Years 8-9) and Senior (Years 10-12).

Teams train for the entire year, during sport class, with additional training sessions before or after school. In years 7 to 10, students develop their basketball skills during specialised practical sessions, as part of their weekly HPE classes. Students also participate in enrichment programs held throughout the year, including our own Basketball Festival and coaching clinics run by local Basketball QLD club - Red-City Roar and NBL team - Brisbane Bullets.

Basketball Academy members compete in interschool basketball, with timing of seasons depending on year level. In this competition, students play against local school teams, with the winner advancing to the Metropolitan Finals. Students can also be selected to represent Alex Hills SHS in the annual Champion Basketball School of QLD competition and the Southside Premier League throughout the year.



How to Apply

To join the Basketball Academy excellence program, students must complete and submit the attached forms, plus attend a trial session. After the application form is submitted, the Basketball Academy coordinator will inform applicants about times when they can trial.

There is an annual program fee for competition entries and compulsory specialist training clinics: \$40 in Year 7 and \$110 in Years 8-12. This fee is subject to change. Additionally, students must purchase a training uniform (a sleeved shirt and basketball shorts). Game jerseys are provided by the school.

It is possible to join Basketball Academy along with our other specialist programs – STEM Academy (classes) and /or Dance Academy (extra-curricular), but students cannot also be part of the Rugby League program, due to conflicting times for games and training.

Basketball Academy – STUDENT CONTRACT

To participate in the Basketball Academy, students are expected represent the school with pride, uphold high standards and actively contribute to the school across a number of areas.

Basketball Academy enrolment is reviewed every 6 months. To maintain a position in the program, student must:

- Demonstrate behaviours that represent being a ‘Safe, Respectful Learner’
- On report cards, achieve a ‘C’ or higher for both Effort and Behaviour in all subjects
- Participate fully in all classes and complete classroom work to the best of my ability
- Complete all assessment tasks to the best of my ability, including drafts, and submit them on time
- Behave in a way that does not tarnish the reputation of Alexandra Hills SHS, at school or in the community
- Wear my school uniform in the appropriate manner, and adhere to the dress code for haircuts and jewellery
- Follow teachers’ instructions – first time, every time
- Respect other students’ right to learn and my teachers’ right to teach
- Be polite to all members of the school and wider community, always using appropriate language
- Have 90%+ school attendance, with the school notified by a parent / carer for all absences
- Be punctual to every class and bring all required equipment each lesson
- Achieve 90%+ training attendance (including before or after school, court or gym)
- Bring all required equipment to training sessions (training jersey, sports shoes, water bottle, towel etc.)
- Attend all coaching clinic days, guest speakers and Basketball Academy program events
- Be available to play in competition events if selected
- Pay the annual Basketball Academy program fee by Week 4 of Term 1 (or have started a Payment Plan)

Consequences for non-compliance:

- You may be withdrawn from games or program events for a period of time
- You may be removed from the Basketball Academy program
- You may be issued other consequences, in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct
- Suspension can be grounds for immediate removal from Basketball Academy
