In years 7 and 8, students study a set list of subjects. These include year-long subjects: English, Mathematics, Science, Humanities and Social Science (HASS). Semester-long subjects are studied on a set rotation over the two years: HPE, LOTE, Technologies, The Arts.

Students also study the “Alex and Me” welfare program throughout each year of school. This covers topics such as: getting organised, friendships, anti-bullying, goals and values, focussing on the future, communication and relationships and online safety.
